You must show you are eligible for our service by bringing original documents with you.

They must be recent.



You will need to show your name, age and address in Brent. As well as a doctor's or hospital letter, or benefit letter to show you are disabled or vulnerable.



You will need to bring other benefit or pension letters if you need advice about these matters.



According to the 1988 Data Protection Act BAS4IL must tell you why personal information about you is collected. We must also tell you what we will use it for and how we will store it.



We need your written consent so we can store your information on our database and in our office files. You will be asked to sign a consent form and data sharing agreement so that we can work with other organisations on your behalf.
